Dear Friend of Frankie Lemmon,

We are officially less than one month away from the 29th Annual Triangle Wine & Food Experience (TWFE) and could not be more excited! In anticipation of the event, we are taking all the necessary precautions to ensure the weekend is compliant with all local health and safety regulations and is as safe as possible for all guests. We've implemented the following policies with everyone's well-being in mind:

- If you plan on attending a TWFE event **proof of full vaccination OR a negative COVID-19 PCR test** result within 72 hours of Thursday, February 3rd at 6:30 P.M **will be required.**
- **Thursday Night Restaurant Dinners** will follow the policies in place at each restaurant, respectively.

Upload your vaccine card or your negative PCR test through your smartphone.

Have a photo of your government issued ID uploaded to your camera roll

1. Follow the prompted steps in preparation for uploading your test results
 - a. Should you need it the Health Protocol ID is RXD5-V4
 - b. NOTE: Each person needs their own account. Please do not upload information for others.
 - c. See attached for helpful instructions on registering with VOW Digital Health

If you are choosing to take a PCR test, we will send you an email reminder closer to the event.

If you **do not** upload your information prior to the event, you will be expected to show your vaccination card or negative PCR test (dated within 72 hours) for entry. Should you be unable to provide proof of full vaccination OR proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR **you will be denied entry.**

TWFE will follow CDC guidance, the latest public health science, and the cities of Raleigh and Durham mandates. If you are experiencing symptoms such as a fever, cough, muscle or body aches, congestion or running nose, shortness of breath, or have knowingly been exposed to or infected with the COVID-19 virus but are not showing symptoms, please do not attend any in-person events.

We fully understand that we are navigating challenging circumstances that impact all of us on a variety of fronts. Thank you for your continued cooperation and support to keep our Frankie Lemmon Family healthy. We look forward to seeing you soon!
